

# TELL YOUR STORY

BEYOND WRITING IT DOWN

When we think about literacy, we often think about reading and writing. When we think of telling a story, we often think about writing it down or telling it orally... How else can we tell a story and what kinds of literacies can we develop?

## Button Maker

**Example:** I have strong environmental literacy and a knowledge of intertidal life. Tell us about you... share a literacy you have developed.

### TRY IT:

Use the button maker, scissors, magazines, pencil crayons & markers to share your story with images, letters and even words.

## Black out Poetry

### TRY IT:

Using markers and a page from an old book, design a story or poem.

## Green Screen



### TRY IT:

Using the app (DO INK) and the green screen, take a photo and apply a green screen background to help tell a story, situate your photo in a different context, disrupt the image, etc.

*NB: You don't need fancy equipment to create your own Green Screen. Try using sheets of paper or even a wall for the screen and replace the app with most any photo editing software (with a little practice!)*



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
