

## Windows/Mac Setup




Step 1: Plug-In



Use the provided USB cord to connect OBSBOT to digital device
Plug into USB or USB-C port on device and USB-C into OBSBOT

■ Use provided USB-C to USB adaptor if needed



• Light on the **front** of OBSBOT should be **solid green** 



Step 2: Setup (tripod or magnetic monitor/desktop attachment)

• If using tripod, screw into bottom of OBSBOT



- Place on flat surface
- If using monitor/desktop attachment attach magnetic end to bottom of OBSBOT

• Place where desired on either a monitor or desktop surface

Step 3: Test

- For **Windows** open **Camera** application by using the bottom left **search bar** on your windows machine OR
  - Find it through the **Start menu** in the bottom left of your screen
- For Mac open LaunchPad and test using FaceTime, Photo Booth, Markup, or head pointer.

Step 4: Start AI Tracking

- To start tracking, **wave right hand** next to face (when doing this do not obscure or cover your face in the process)
  - OBSBOT should blink blue then go back to solid green indicating it is now tracking
- To stop tracking, **wave left hand** next to face
