Windows Setup (Mac 10.6.4 or higher setup after)

Step 1: Remove Microphone and USB Cable from Kit

• Connect Cable to Underside of Microphone and USB-A end to Personal Device (PC, Laptop, iPad, etc.)



Step 2: Ensure Input and Output Systems are Correctly Designated

• Move to bottom right corner or wherever your Speaker icon is on your computer



• Right click Speaker Icon and left click Open Sound Settings



- On page ensure **Output** is set to Monitor Display Audio, Speakers, or Headphones you have connected
 - NOT Speakers (Yeti Stereo Microphone)

- Input should be set as Microphone (Yeti Stereo Microphone)
 - You can test the microphone by speaking into it and seeing if the line labeled as **Test your microphone** moves with the sound of your voice
 - If the line does not move, check the Mute button on the mic to see if it is lit up solid.
 - If it is blinking, it means the mic is muted so just press the red light once to unmute and test again.



Mac (10.6.4 or higher) Setup Up

Step 1: Plug microphone into your computer's USB port using the provided USB cable.

Step 2: From the main Apple Menu, select the System Preferences.

Step 3: Select the Sound icon.

Step 4: Now select the Input tab and select "Yeti Stereo Microphone"

Step 5: Select the output tab and select "Yeti Stereo Microphone"
